Secretary's Report (Shannon Holbrook)

- May 19, 2015 meeting minutes presented. Athena Panos moved to accept minutes as presented and Sandy Scheinbaum seconded. MINUTES ACCEPTED.

Treasurer's Report (Andre Schimmelbusch)

- Reviewed and voted on July and August 2015 Financial Reports presented by Andre Schimmelbusch.
- From July 1-Sept 28, 2015 we received \$9,759.88 in revenue; total actual expenses \$9,759.55
- \$1006.88 on the Fun Run for shirts & misc. supplies.
- \$50 on raffle sales supplies
- \$3,356.44 on the Spring fundraiser – Auction
- \$2000 on scholarships
- \$434.28 other misc PTSA events/committees
- \$1000 on YMCA for Fitness Friday's – Running Club
- \$1455.34 on Admin & Membership misc expenses; which mostly included start of school event
- \$456.61 on operating expenses & safety patrol

Principal's Report (Tracey Naylor)

- Ms. Naylor welcomed everyone to the new year and first PTSA meeting along with the kinder teachers who were hosting their classroom for the meeting.
- She presented a presentation on the recent years' assessment on some data taken on college readiness, common core and how it relates to math, state expectations, and how Hazelwood is doing in comparison to the state and other Renton Schools.
- She discussed briefly the new reading curriculum adoptions and phonics programs new for this year. The new discovery and highly-capable programs also new to Hazelwood. The new computer tools that can be used at home for added learning.
- The increase in total enrollment this year is 629, from 540 last year and that next year there is a discussion/plan for additional portables. Total of 26 classrooms.
